**Re: Year 11 GCSE Examination Arrangements on Eid Day**

I would like to start this letter by wishing you and your family Eid Mubarak for Friday. As you are aware, the exam board has scheduled GCSE exams for Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June. **Your daughter must attend their exam/s on Friday.** The timing of the GCSE exams are set nationally and the school has no control over when they are scheduled. It is not possible to retake an exam on a different date, and any pupil who fails to attend an exam will receive a U grade.

**All students are expected to attend their English Language exam on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June; students must arrive by 8.30am.** Geography students have an exam in the afternoon. As the exam needs to start promptly **students who are taking the geography exam are welcome to stay in school or go home after the exam has finished.** If you wish your child to stay in school just contact the school or email Mrs Kennie. **Geography students who are going home after their English exam must arrive at school for 12.35pm**

As it is Eid, many pupils may have Mendhi on their hands. The exam board has stated that pupils will be allowed to have Mendhi on their hands during their exams. As a school we will continue to carry out routine checks in line with JCQ requirements to ensure that no unauthorised notes or materials are present on a candidate's person during exams.
